| Summary of discussion             | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. This was the first meeting of the newly formed Chaplaincy Collaborative within NHS London following the agreement by colleagues in autumn 2006 of a move to this new structure.</li> <li>2. Mark Folland, Lead Chaplain, Caring for the Spirit Strategy for the N W of England led a discussion of the varieties of models for chaplaincy services. This was based upon the Guidance Note on Models of Healthcare Chaplaincy that Mark had written in 2006.</li> <li>3. There followed a discussion of some of the issues raised by the paper and MF's address.</li> <li>4. Discussion concerning the future of the Collaborative in its new form focussed briefly upon the need to make sure that there was adequate representation from the Trusts in London. Concern was also expressed about the relatively small attendance at this meeting although it had been publicised well in advance. SH explained that although there was no formal SHA link, despite having approached the SHA and had a meeting about this, Richard Osborn (previously link for the NW London Collaborative) had kindly agreed to maintain an informal link with the pan-London Collaborative. Richard is now Strategic Library Services Development Manager for NHS London. Those present agreed to continue with the Collaborative on the basis of the benefits already experienced in the smaller groupings.</li> </ol> |
